Wood Haven Technology Park Development Western Virginia Regional Industrial Facility Authority

July 2019

Work will soon be underway on improvements to the property now known as the Wood Haven Technology Park. You'll see construction going on at the property and this letter is to let you know what, when, and why.

In August, work will begin to bring water and sewer lines across Wood Haven Road and to the entrance to the property which will be to the west of the church. The project will also include construction of an entrance to accommodate a four-lane entrance road with landscaped median. We anticipate the work to be completed by the end of 2019.

Once utility construction is complete, a contract will be awarded for entrance landscaping, curb and gutter construction and paving. We anticipate beginning in the spring of 2020. The development plan also includes relocating utility lines from the north side of Wood Haven Road to the south side. This work is planned during the summer and will involve new wooden poles in the same locations as existing ones on the south side of the road.

Finally, the former Amos house will be demolished in late summer. We have decided to take this step to avoid potential vandalism and other nuisance activity.

The Authority will make every effort to keep you informed of progress on this project and is committed to creating as little disruption as possible.
