MINUTES

The January meeting of the WVRIFA Participation Committee for the Wood Haven Road Project was held on Friday, January 20, 2023 at 10:00 a.m. at the Roanoke Valley-Alleghany Regional Commission office (Top Floor Conference Room), 313 Luck Avenue, SW, Roanoke VA.

1. CALL MEETING TO ORDER

Chair Cowell called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

2. ROLL CALL

5. <u>BUSINESS READY SITES PROGRAM APLICATION UPDATE</u>

John Hull reported that Governor Youngkin announced on January 16, 2023 a total of \$90 million in Virginia Business Ready Sites Program (VBRSP) development grants for 21 sites across the Commonwealth. WVRIFA was successful in securing \$504, 149.
