MINUTES

The October meeting of the WVRIFA Participation Committee for the Wood Haven Road Project was held on Friday, October 18, 2024 at 10:00 a.m. at the Roanoke Regional Partnership (Conference Room), 111 Franklin Road SE Ste.333, Roanoke VA.

NOTE: The October 18, 2024 Meetings of the WVRIFA Participation Committee and the WVRIFA Board were held simultaneously (jointly) since several items on both agendas were the same.

1. CALL MEETING TO ORDER

Chair Chris Dorsey called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

2. ROLL CALL

Chair Dorsey welcomed those in attendance and asked Ms. Virginia Mullen to call the roll. Ms. Mullen noted that a quorum was established.
